GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The device DAT8019 is a Modbus TCP server unit that can convert up to 8 analogue signals applied to the input in engineering units in digital format. The inputs can be connected to 2 wires RTDs or resistance sensors. The input channels are electrically isolated in pairs.

The device guarantees high accuracy and a stable measure versus time and temperature. In order to ensure the safety plant, the device is equipped with a Watch-Dog Timer system. The Ethernet interface allows reading and writing in real time the values of the internal registers of the device.

The LEDs of signalling of Ethernet activity and power supply allow a direct monitoring of the system functionality. The built-in Web Server allows the remote visualization, acquisition of the analogue inputs and the access to the main Ethernet programming parameters. The device is also configurable by the software *Dev9K*, a free IDE developed by DATEXEL. The connection is made by removable screw-terminals (inputs and power supply) and RJ-45 plug (Ethernet). The DAT8019 is in compliance with the Directive UL 61010-1 for US market and with the Directive CSA C22.2 No 61010-1 for the Canadian market. The device realizes a full electrical isolation between the lines, introducing a valid protection against the effects of all ground loops eventually existing in industrial applications. The device is housed in a rough self-extinguishing plastic enclosure which, thanks to its thin profile of 22,5 mm only, allows a high density mounting on EN-50022 standard DIN rail.

USER INSTRUCTIONS

Before to install the device, please read the "Installation Instruction" section. To configure the device use the INIT modality (refer to the User Guide of the device). Connect power supply, Ethernet and analogue inputs as shown in the "Wiring" section. The LEDs state depends on the working condition of the device: see the "Light Signalling" section to verify the device working state. To perform configuration and calibration operations, read the instructions in the User Guide of the device. To simplify handling or replacing of the device, it is possible to remove the wired terminals even with the device powered.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The device is suitable for fitting to DIN rails in vertical position. For optimum operation and long life follow these instructions:

When the devices are installed side by side it is necessary to separate them by at least:

- 10 mm if the UL certification is required.
- 5 mm if the UL certification is not required.

Make sure that sufficient air flow is provided for the device avoiding to place raceways or other objects which could obstruct the ventilation slits. Moreover it is suggested to avoid that devices are mounted above appliances generating heat; their ideal place should be in the lower part of the panel.

Install the device in a place without vibrations.

Moreover it is suggested to avoid routing conductors near power signal cables (motors, induction ovens, inverters, etc...) and to use shielded cable for connecting signals.





ISOLATIONS STRUCTURE






ANALOGUE INPUTS
